In the proceedings against

the swimmer Xinyi CHEN affiliated to the <u>China Swimming Association</u>

It was decided in Windsor (Canada) on 7th December 2016:

Ms Xinyi Chen is found to have committed an anti-doping rule violation under FINA DC Rule 2.1 – presence of a prohibited substance Hydrochlorothiazide in an athlete's sample (Class S5 of the WADA Prohibited List 2016, Diuretics and Masking Agents).

Ms Xinyi Chen is sanctioned with two (2) years ineligibility period in accordance with the FINA DC Rule 10.2.2. The sanction starts on 11 August 2016, day of her provisional suspension.

All costs of this case shall be borne by the China Swimming Association in accordance with FINA DC 12.3.

Any appeal against this decision may be referred to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), Lausanne, Switzerland not later than twenty one (21) days after receipt of the complete and reasoned judgement (FINA Rule C 12.11.4 and DC 13.7).

The FINA Doping Panel acknowledges the CAS Panel decision regarding the disqualification of athlete's result obtained in the Olympic Games Rio 2016.
