

FIA ANTI-DOPING DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Mr Jiří SEDLÁČEK – Decision notified on 13.08.2012

Mr Jiří Sedláček, who took part in the Šternberk (CZE) event counting towards the 2012 FIA Historic Hill-Climb Championship and who was selected for a doping control on 2 June 2012, tested positive for methylprednisolone (a glucocorticosteroid) belonging to Section S.9 of the World Anti-Doping Agency Prohibited List.

The FIA Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee (ADC) held a hearing on this case in Paris on 20 July 2012.

Decision of the ADC

The ADC concluded that an Anti-Doping Rule Violation according to Article 2.1 of the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations – "Presence of a Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in a Driver's Sample" – was established.

As a consequence, the ADC has decided to impose the following sanctions on Mr Jiří Sedláček:

- 1) A Sanction of Reprimand;
- 2) Disqualification of the result obtained by the Athlete in the Šternberk (CZE) event of the 2012 FIA Historic Hill-Climb Championship, with all of the resulting consequences including forfeiture of any trophies, points and prizes.

Mr Jiří Sedláček has 21 days in which to appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
