1. The charge by Drug Free Sport New Zealand (DFS) was a violation of Rule 3.1 of the

Sports Anti-Doping Rules 2012 (SADR) as a result of Kurt Allan's positive test to D-

methamphetamine and D-amphetamine in competition at the Men's Final of the

National Fastpitch Softball Championships on 9 December 2012. He was

provisionally suspended by another division of the Tribunal on 10 January 2013.

2. The substances detected are non-specified substances prohibited in competition

under s6. Stimulants (a: Non-Specified Stimulants) of the 2012 WADA Prohibited List.

3. Mr Allan admitted the violation. The period of ineligibility (suspension) for this

violation is two years under SADR 14.2. Mr Allan has been represented during the

process by Mr Patterson. Mr Allan initially filed a Form 2 Notice on 20 February

2013 seeking to be heard in relation to sanctions. Subsequently Mr Allan advised,

through Mr Patterson, that he did not wish to present a case on sanctions and would

abide by the decision of the Tribunal.

4. Accordingly a two year period of ineligibility under SADR 14.2 (in terms of SADR

14.10.1) must be imposed. Mr Allan was provisionally suspended on 10 January

2013 and the two year period of ineligibility will run from that date (SADR 14.9.3).

5. Mr Allan is disqualified from any individual results in the National Fastpitch

Championships. If any team results are affected the consequences are a matter for

any applicable rule of the sport.

6. During the period of ineligibility Mr Allan may not participate in any capacity in a

competition or activity authorised or organised by Softball New Zealand or a softball

club or in any similar activities in any other sport which is a signatory to the Rules.
