### DOPING VIOLATION

Spanish Inline Hockey Player

**Adel Saber Bachiller**

receives three (6) month sports ban


The International Federation of Roller Sports (FIRS) today acknowledged the decision of El Comité Nacional de Competición y Disciplina Deportiva (CNCDD) de la RFEP to impose a three (6) month ban on inline hockey competitor **Adel Saber Bachiller** for the presence and use of metabolites of THC (cannabis) above the permitted limit.

The prohibited substance was detected in a sample collected in competition from Sn Adel Saber Bachiller in Valladolid, at the Liga Elite Masculina de Hockey sobre Patines en Linea at Valladolid, Spain on 24 March 2012.

Sn Adel Saber Bachiller's ban means he is ineligible to participate, as an athlete or support person, in any sport that has adopted the World Anti-doping Code until 5 January 2013.

The results obtained by Sn Adel Saber Bachiller at the Liga Elite Masculina de Hockey sobre Patines en Linea also disqualified and any medals, points and prizes awarded to him are forfeited.

THC is classed as a specified substance on the World Anti-doping Agency's Prohibited List and is prohibited in competition.
