DOPING VIOLATION

Swiss inline Hockey Skater **Cedric Lipp**

Two (2) year sports ban imposed by the Swiss olympic disciplinary

The International Federation of Roller Sports (FIRS) today acknowledged the decision of Swiss Olympic Disciplinary Chamber to impose a two (2) year sports banned and 1600 SF fine on Swiss inline hockey player for presence of Clenbuterol and Methandienon in a sample collected during doping control.

The ban takes effect from 2 July 2013 and ends on 1 July 2015. All prizes and awards received from the date of collection of the first positive sample are forfeit.

The sports ban means that Cedric Lipp is ineligible to participate, as an athlete or support person, in any sport that has adopted the World Anti-doping Code from 2 July 2013 to 1 July 2015.
