Summoned on 20.08.2012, 10:00 H, at the National Anti-Doping Agency official seat in Bucharest, 37 – 39 Basarabia Bvd., District 2, for the hearing of the athlete **Schlechta Chris-Paul-Laszlo**, registered to Gold Star Baia Mare Sport Club, residing in Baia Mare, Maramures County, 5 Dr. Victor Babes Street, Appt 18 establishes:

Following the doping control conducted on 26.05.2012 on the occasion of the National Bodybuilding Championship in Medias, the analytical result of the athlete Schlechta Chris-Paul-Laszlo's sample, with the code number **2707260A**, indicated the presence of a T/E ratio >4 by the administration of testosterone or pro-hormones of testosterone and the result was confirmed by the Cologne Doping Control Laboratory.

On 07.08.2012, the athlete showed to the Hearing Commission meeting where he stated that he used the food supplements MUSCLETECH and AMINOSTAR. He also stated he was going to send those supplements to be analyzed to show if the laboratory result is due or not to the fact that he used those products.

The Hearing Commission decided to analyze the product to establish if the result was due to the use of this food supplements, as well as the athlete's provisional suspension by Decision no. 18/07.08.2012. The Commission also stated that the athlete used those supplements without medical prescription as required by the Law no. 511/2006 for approval of the Government Ordinance no. 59/2006 regarding the use of food supplements by athletes. The athlete did not respect the deadline to send the supplements to be analyzed.

The *Hearing Commission for athletes and their support personnel who violated the anti-doping rules*, after reviewing the documents within the file, the analysis bulletin no. 553/24.07.2012 of Bucharest Doping Control Laboratory and the analysis bulletin no. S20124697 of Cologne Doping Control Laboratory, the nature of the used food supplements, as well as the national and international legal provisions:

DECIDES

The ineligibility of the athlete Schlechta Chris-Paul-Laszlo, registered to Gold Star Baia Mare Sport Club for a period of two (2) years from any sport activity, pursuant to article 38 of the Law 227/2006 regarding prevention and fight against doping in sport, republished with subsequent amendments, as the athlete violated the provisions of article 2, paragraph (2), letter a) of the mentioned law.

The ineligibility period begins to run from the date of the current decision, while the provisional suspension period of 13 days from 07.08.2012 to 19.08.2012 shall be credited against the total period of ineligibility.

Pursuant to the provisions of art. 45 of the mentioned law, during the ineligibility period, the athlete has to submit his whereabouts information to the Agency. Aiming to reintegrate in sport activity, during the ineligibility period, the athlete has to undergo four no advance notice doping tests, one of them at the moment when the sport activity is started again. When the athlete firstly retires from sport activity during the ineligibility period and then he requests to be reintegrated in sport activity, he won't be reintegrated until he informs the Agency and no advance notice doping testing is performed during a period of time equal to the ineligibility period remained when he retired.

The decision shall be communicated to the athlete Schlechta Chris-Paul-Laszlo, Gold Star Baia Mare Sport Club, Romanian Bodybuilding and Fitness Federation, National Authority for Sport and Youth, Romanian Olympic and Sport Committee, World Bodybuilding and Fitness Federation and World Anti-Doping Agency.

The decision may be appealed to the Appeal Commission besides National Anti-Doping Agency in 21 days since its notification.

Romanian Bodybuilding and Fitness Federation has the obligation to apply the provisions of the current decision and to comply with the legal provisions in force pursuant to the provisions of the articles 37 and 71 of the Law 227/2006.

Pursuant to the provisions of art. 36, paragraph (4) of Law 227/2006 regarding prevention and fight against doping in sport, republished, with subsequent

amendments, the above-mentioned institutions are required to maintain confidentiality of the information communicated, until the public disclosure of the case.
