DECISION
NO. 12/ 09.10.2006

Sanctions Committee, assembled on 04.10.2006, 11:00 h, at National Anti-Doping Agency official seat from Bucharest, 37 – 39 Basarabia Bvd., sect. 2, after reviewing the file no. 12 / 2006, establishes the followings:

On 02.10.2006, Hearing Commission assembled for reviewing the case of the athlete **VARGA SEBASTIAN MIREL**, registered to MSC BISTRITA – sports discipline TRACK AND FIELD, having the address: village Mihai Viteazu, no.15A, commune Mihai Viteazu, district Cluj, having the identity card with series KX, no. 317506, issued by Turda Police, on 09.12.2003.

In the biological sample with code number 989596 of the athlete **VARGA SEBASTIAN MIREL**, the following metabolites have been detected: 3' hidroxi Stanozolol and 4 β – hidroxi Stanozolol.

The Committee taking note of the documents within the file, respectively athlete's statement, according to which he renounced at the right of B Sample analysis (counter-expertise), coach's statement, analysis report, the minute of Hearing Commission, doping control form and additional report form – Commentaries - and taking into account international and national legal provisions in this field

DECIDES

The ineligibility of athlete **VARGA SEBASTIAN MIREL**, registered to MSC BISTRITA for a 2 (two) years period, in compliance with art.2, paragraph 2 a, b and c of the Law 227 / 2006 regarding the prevention and fight against doping in sport.

The ineligibility period becomes effective on the sample collection day.

The present decision may be appealed in a 10 days period starting with the notification day, at the Appeal Commission.

In case of not appealing, the decision becomes compulsory after the above mentioned period.

The decision shall be communicated to the athlete, the club where he is registered, national sport federation, National Sports Agency, Romanian Olympic and Sports Committee.

National Sports Federation has the responsibility to put the decision into operation.
