DECISION
NO. 1 / 23.04.2007

Sanctions Committee, assembled on 23.04.2007, 09:00 h, at National Anti-Doping Agency official seat from Bucharest, 37 – 39 Basarabia Bvd., sect. 2, after reviewing the file no. 1 / 2007, establishes the followings:

On 19.04.2007, *Hearing Commission for the athletes and athletes' support personnel* assembled for reviewing the case of the athlete **HREAPCA ELENA OANA**, registered to "Unirea" Alba Iulia Sport Club, having the address: Rediu, Iasi district, who, following to doping control conducted on 28.02.2007, has been found positive with **nandrolone metabolite, 19-norandrosteron in a concentration higher than 2ng/ ml**.

Sanctions Committee taking note of the documents within the file i.e. athlete's statement admitting the use of the above mentioned substance, the bulletin of analysis and taking into account the provisions of the Decision no. 1/ 19.04.2007 of the *Hearing Commission for the athletes and their support personnel* as well as international and national legal provisions in this field

DECIDES

The ineligibility of athlete **HREAPCA ELENA OANA**, registered to "Unirea" Alba Iulia Sport Club for a 2 (two) years period, in compliance with the provisions of the Law no. 227/ 2006 regarding prevention and fight against doping in sport, as he was found guilty for violating art. 2, paragraph (2), letters a) and b) of the above-mentioned Law .

The ineligibility period becomes effective on the date of the present decision.

The present decision may be appealed in a 10 days period since notification, to the Appeal Commission beside National Anti-Doping Agency. The decision becomes mandatory at the end of the above-mentioned 10 days period.

In case of not appealing, the decision becomes compulsory after the above mentioned period.

The decision shall be communicated to the athlete, the club where she is registered, national sport federation, National Sports Agency, Romanian Olympic and Sports Committee and World Anti-Doping Agency.

National Sports Federation has the responsibility to put the decision into operation.
