DECISION
No. 10/17.10.2007

The Sanctions Committee met on 17.10.2007 at 10h00, at the National Anti-Doping Agency's official seat in Bucharest, 37-39 Basarabia Blvd, District 2, reviewing the file no. 12/2007, establishes the following:

On 10.10.2007, the Hearing Commission was convened to review the case of the athlete **BOGATI Arpad**, registered at **"Sebastiano" Sport Club in Reghin**, having the domicile in Petelia, 95 Main Street, Mureș County, following the doping control conducted on 16.09.2007 and the detection of **4β metabolite – hydroxystanozolol** and the substance **clopamide** in the athlete's urine sample.

The Sanctions Committee, reviewing the documents from the file and the bulletin of analysis and taking into account the provisions of the Hearing Commission's Decision no. 12/10.10.2007 and the legal national and international provisions:

DECIDES

The ineligibility of the athlete **BOGATI Arpad**, registered at **"Sebastiano" Sport Club in Reghin**, for a period of two (2) years, according to the provisions of Article 31 of the Law no. 227/2006 regarding the prevention and fight against doping in sport, being found guilty for the violation of Article 2 paragraph (2) a) of the above mentioned Law.

The ineligibility period shall start with the date of the present decision.

The present decision may be appealed in 10 days from its notification, to the Appeal Commission besides National Anti-Doping Agency; after the expiring of the above mentioned term, the decision shall become mandatory.

The present decision shall be notified to the athlete, the sport club where he is registered, the relevant national sport federation, National Sports Agency, Romanian Olympic and Sports Committee, as well as to World Anti-Doping Agency.

The relevant National Sport Federation shall have the responsibility to implement the provisions of the present decision.
