DECISION

No. 6/04.08.2009

The *Hearing Commission for athletes and their support personnel who violated the anti-doping rules*, summoned on 04.08.2009, 10:00 H, at the National Anti-Doping Agency official seat in Bucharest, 37 – 39 Basarabia Bvd., sector 2, to review the file no. 11/2009 of the athlete **Mihail Bogdan SINESCU**, registered to **National College Aurel Vlaicu**, residing in Bucharest, 84, Mitropolit Varlan street, sector 1, establishes:

Following the doping control on 07.06.2009, sport discipline Rugby, on the occasion of Championship for Juniors U19, organized in Bucharest, the analytical result of the athlete **Mihail Bogdan SINESCU**, with the code number **2435332A**, indicated the presence of the **11-nor-delta 9-tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic (carboxi THC)**, metabolite of **tetrahydrocannabinol (THC)**, **over the limit of 15 ng/ml**, result confirmed by the Doping Control Laboratory of Cologne, Germany.

The substance detected in athlete's sample is included in the class S8. of the Prohibited List as a specific substance.

The *Hearing Commission for athletes and their support personnel who violated the anti-doping rules* reviewed the documents within the file, namely the analysis bulletin no. 280/02.07.2009 of Bucharest Doping Control Laboratory, subsequently confirmed by the analysis bulletin no. S2009 003 269 of Cologne Doping Control Laboratory and athlete's statement of 04.08.2009, taking into account that the athlete does not request the analysis of B sample, pursuant to the legal provisions on national and international level:

DECIDES

The ineligibility of the athlete **Mihail Bogdan SINESCU**, registered to **National College Aurel Vlaicu**, for a period of 3 (three) months, pursuant to the provisions of the art. 37, thesis II of the Law 227/2006 regarding the prevention and

fight against doping in sport republished as he is guilty of violating the provisions of the art. 2 paragraph (2) letter a) of the mentioned law.

The ineligibility period starts at the date of the current decision.

The decision may be appealed in 21 days since the notification to the Appeal Commission besides National Anti-Doping Agency, the decision becoming mandatory once the above-mentioned term expires.

The decision shall be communicated to the athlete, the club where he is registered, to Romanian Rugby Federation, the Ministry of Youth and Sport, Romanian Olympic and Sport Committee, relevant international federation and the World Anti-Doping Agency.

Romanian Rugby Federation has the obligation to apply the provisions of the current decision and to comply with the legal provisions in force in compliance with the provisions of the article 65, paragraph (1) of the Law 227/2006 republished.
