## Mr Pál LÓNYAI

## Appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport

Mr Pál Lónyai (HUN), who participated in the Baja Poland event of the FIA World Cup for Cross-Country Rallies, on 1 September 2013, tested positive for Benzoylecgonine and Ecgonine methyl ester, both being metabolites of cocaine, which is a non-specified stimulant registered under point S6 of the 2013 World Anti-Doping Agency Prohibited List.

By decision notified on 14 April 2014, the FIA Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee disqualified Mr Pál Lónyai from the individual result achieved in the Baja Poland event of the FIA World Cup for Cross-Country Rallies.

The FIA Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee did not suspend Mr Pál Lónyai from competition, after taking into consideration the fact that he had established that had not been at fault and had not been negligent in this particular case.

The FIA has decided to appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), based in Lausanne, Switzerland.

An Award will be made in due course by the Panel to be constituted by the CAS.
