Brussels, 20 February 2014

At the request of the CISM Secretary General, the CISM Discipline Commission convened for an official meeting at the CISM General Secretariat on the 11<sup>th</sup> of February 2014.

The CISM Discipline Commission was requested to analyze the case of a positive doping result, occurred during the World Military Wrestling Championship at Tehran, Iran, from 22 to 28 October 2013.

The CISM Discipline Commission:

**Considered** the Analysis Result Record sent by the WADA accredited laboratory of Cologne, Germany, stating that the sample code 2274943 showed an adverse result for **testosterone/epitestosterone ratio > 4**, and an **exogenous origin of testosterone metabolites**, classified as "S1.1. Anabolic Agents"; **methylprednisolone**, classified as "S9 Glucocorticosteroids", and **methylhexaneamine**, classified as "S6 Stimulants", all of them included on the WADA Prohibited List, version 2013;

**Considered** the Doping Control Form confirming that the bottle number 2274943 belongs to MAHER FAEEZ ASEM member of the Iraqi Delegation;

**Considered** the email sent by the Iraqi Delegation, stating the receipt of the Doping case confirmation concerning the aforementioned athlete as well as the no reply on behalf of the same Delegation when asked about the sample B testing and their presence at the Hearing Panel;

**Considered** the athlete didn't answer the CISM request to be present at, or to send a representative to the Hearing Panel, on 11 February 2014;

The CISM Discipline Commission, after analyses of the records and files available at the CISM General Secretariat, taking into consideration the WADA Code and the CISM Anti-doping Rules, formulates the following conclusion and sanctions:


1. The athlete is considered to have committed an anti-doping rule violation during the above mentioned CISM sport event at Tehran, Iran;

2. According article 10.2 of the WADA Code, the athlete is suspended from participating in any CISM event for a period of 2 (two) years, starting from the date of Hearing Panel, 11 February 2014;

3. The Iraqi Delegation is to arrange the return of the individual bronze medal, awarded to MAHER FAEEZ ASEM, to the CISM General Secretariat not later than 31 March 2014. After this date, the CISM SG will reallocate the medals amongst the medal winners;

The CISM Discipline Commission decided to communicate the case and the current decisions to the responsible authorities: WADA, the International Wrestling Federation (FILA), the Iraqi Anti-Doping Agency, the Iraqi Delegation to CISM, and MAHER FAEEZ ASEM (through the Iraqi Delegation).

According to the CISM Anti-Doping Rules, Art 12.2.1, the athlete can lodge an appeal with the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) against the present decision.
