

FIA ANTI-DOPING DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Mr Marc AMEZ-DROZ – Decision notified on 25.09.2014

Mr Marc AMEZ-DROZ (CHE), who participated in the Brands Hatch event of the FIA Lurani Trophy for Formula Junior Cars and who was selected for a doping control on 25 May 2014, tested positive for Hydrochlorothiazide, a diuretic registered under point S5 of the 2014 World Anti-Doping Agency Prohibited List.

The FIA Anti-Doping Disciplinary Committee (ADC) held a hearing in this case by telephone on 12 August 2014.

Decision of the ADC

The ADC has concluded that an Anti-Doping Rule Violation according to Article 2.1 of the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations – "Presence of Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers in a driver's Sample" – has been established.

As a consequence, the ADC has decided to impose the following sanctions on Mr Marc AMEZ-DROZ:

- 1. A sanction of two years of ineligibility, starting on 25 May 2014 and expiring on 25 May 2016;
- 2. A disqualification of the competitive results obtained by Mr Marc AMEZ-DROZ during the event, as well as any competitive results achieved as from 25 May 2014, with all of the resulting consequences including forfeiture of any trophies, points and prizes.

Mr Marc AMEZ-DROZ has 21 days in which to appeal this decision to the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
