## What do IFs look for in a NADO partner

- Union of European Football Associations
- 54 member associations
- A continental confederation under FIFA
  - not an International Federation
  - not FIFA
- Testing jurisdiction is based on participation in UEFA competitions
- UEFA is not a Code signatory but is Code-compliant





### A lot of players

- Approximately 14,000 players per season participate from 54 member countries
- UCL mean (last 3 seasons): 2445 players
- UEL mean (last 3 seasons): 5659 players



### High turnover

- 2482 players in UCL in 2015/16
- Only 960 of them also played in 2014/15
- Only 490 played last 3 seasons
- 34/78 clubs in UCL this season were not in competition last season (12/32 in group stage)



What are we trying to do?

- Prevent doping and promote fair play
- Protect player health
- Ensure European football has suitable anti-doping programme
- Protect the integrity of our competitions
- Educate and inform players and support staff

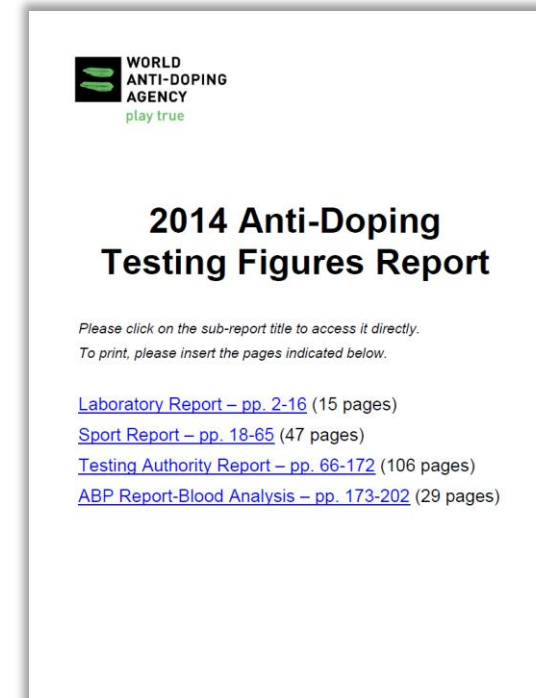

RESPECT

- 31,242 samples were analysed in football (2014 WADA stats)
  - 15.5% Brazilian Football Confederation
  - 10.1% CONI
  - 7.4% UEFA (2318 samples)
    - IC: urine 1515, blood 60
    - OOC: urine 509, blood 234





## Developments for smarter testing in 2015

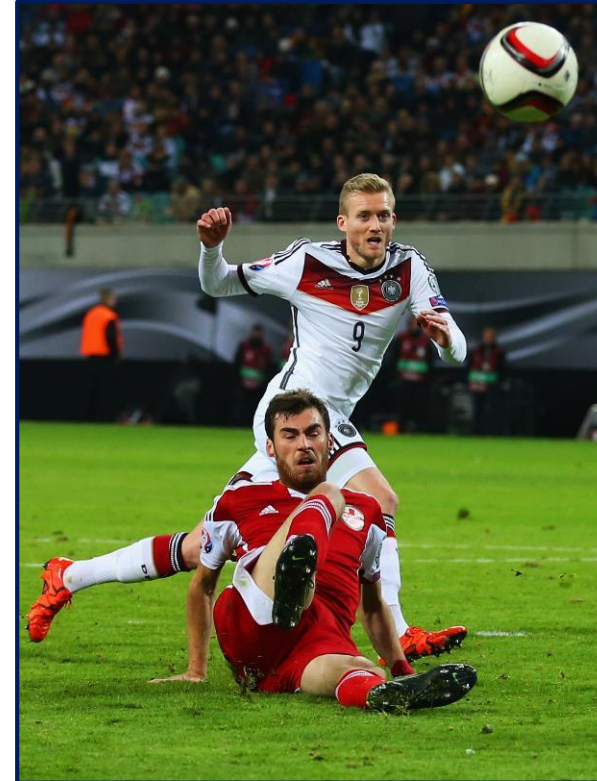
WE CARE ABOUT FOOTBALL



- Changes to our team whereabouts rules
  - Individual whereabouts if player not involved in team activity
  - Code-compliant failures
- Introduction of biological passport
  - Steroidal module in 2015
  - Haematological module for EURO 2016
  - Approx. 25% increase in tests for 2015/16 season
- Sample storage and re-testing
  - Samples from main competitions now stored for minimum 4 years
  - Re-testing when required by:
    - Suspicious profile of player
    - New analysis method for previously undetectable substance



- UEFA has signed 21 collaboration agreements with NADOs
  - Austria, Belgium (Flanders and Wallonie), Belarus, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, UK
- Collaboration agreements cover:
  - Testing: test distribution plans, jurisdiction, reciprocal testing
  - Sharing: testing data, intelligence, whereabouts information
  - ABP programme: passport custodianship, putting DCFs into ADAMS, follow-up testing, results management
  - Education





- ABP: UEFA has read access to NADO's passports and vice-versa
  - Enables overview of all testing in European football
- All 32 UCL clubs send whereabouts to UEFA and NADOs
  - Reduces work/errors for administrators and teams
- UEFA's testing plans shared with NADOs
  - NADOs are informed of tests in their country and on teams from their country
- NADOs' testing plans shared with UEFA
  - Modification of testing plans based on information received
- Reciprocal testing – allows wider reach and greater reactivity
  - Rapid target tests following APMU recommendation
- Adding DCFs to ADAMS when NADOs don't use it
  - E.g. NADA provides us with all their DCFs
  - Maximizes benefit of steroidal biological passport
- Education: NADO experts conducting education sessions at UEFA youth championships
  - Dominic Müser from NADA and Anders Radström from Swedish Sports Confederation





- UEFA working closely with NADOs to ensure best possible testing programme in run-up to EURO 2016
  - 552 players from 24 teams will participate in final tournament
  - Approx. 750 payers in pre-tournament training squads
- Aim to have all players tested before tournament
  - Steroid and blood passports
- Only possible if UEFA collaborates with NADOs

### Pre-Competition Test Planning

- First team whereabouts covering international match week 21 – 29 March will be sent to NADOs tomorrow Monday 14<sup>th</sup> March
- NADOs' to communicate by 15<sup>th</sup> March:
  - their planned testing activity from now until the beginning of EURO on 5<sup>th</sup> June
  - Details of quantity and type (e.g. urine/blood/ESAs/hGH) of test planned
- UEFA will then be able to schedule and balance its tests accordingly





## ADAMS Updates

- Approx. 750 participating players will become part of UEFA's EURO Testing Pool
- NADOs' to support by ensuring that:
  - Passport custodianship are transferred to UEFA
  - Nationality and Sport Nationality under your custody is correct
  - Sport Nationality is the Country in which the player plays his/her club football
  - "How to do it" Guidelines have been sent
  - By 18<sup>th</sup> March
