

## **Korea Anti-Doping Agency Announces Final Testing Number for 2008**

The Korea Anti-Doping Agency (KADA) administered a total number of 3,020 doping control tests in 2008, KADA President Keun-Youl Kim announced. Of those tests, 2,471 doping control tests were conducted on Korean Athletes under the Korea Anti-Doping Program. An additional 549 user-pay tests were conducted on behalf of national and international sports organizations.

Out-of-Competition(OOC) testing, widely considered to be the most effective method of deterrence, comprised 60% (1,486) of KADA's 2008 domestic tests. OOC testing typically occurs at the athlete's training facility or other location and is performed with no advance notice to the athlete. These 1,486 were primarily targeted at athletes in the KADA registered testing pool and who participated in 2008 Beijing Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The 985 In-Competition(IC) tests accounted for the remaining 40% of KADA's 2008 domestic testing numbers.

Pay user service testing was conducted on behalf of various national and international sports organizations, which amounted to 549 tests during this year. At International Events held in Korea over this year, the KADA conducted 236 tests. 297 user pay OOC tests were also carried out on behalf of International Federations, National Federations and Association of National Anti-Doping Organizations.

13 anti-doping rule violations were reported during this year. 8 bodybuilders and 1 weightlifter received a two-year sanction for the presence of anabolic agents in a sample. A powerlifting athlete was given a two-year sanction for the presence of diuretics and an alpine ski athlete received a reprimand for stimulants. A para alpine skier was given a two-year ineligibility for refusing to provide sample and her coach received a four-year sanction for abetting an anti-doping rule violation.

The KADA is an independent, operating as the central anti-doping organization in charge of carrying out test and result management as well as developing education program.
