प्रस्तावना

प्रतिस्पर्धा नियमों की तरह डोपिंग रोधी नियम ऐसी दशाओं को शासित करने वाले खेलों के नियम हैं, जिनके तहत खेल खेले जाते हैं। एथलीट, एथलीट सहायक कार्मिक और अन्य व्यक्ति भाग लेने की शर्तें के रूप में इन नियमों को स्वीकार करते हैं और वे इन नियमों द्वारा बाध्य होते हैं। ये खेल विशिष्ट नियम और प्रक्रियाएं, जिनका उद्देश्य वैश्विक और सौहार्दपूर्ण परिवेश में डोपिंग रोधी सिद्धांतों को लागू करना है, सुस्पष्ट होते हैं। राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (नाडा) ने विश्व डोपिंग रोधी संहिता ("संहिता") स्वीकार की है। ये डोपिंग रोधी नियम संहिता के तहत नाडा की जिम्मेदारियों के अनुरूप स्वीकार किए गए हैं और लागू किए गए हैं, और ये भारत में डोपिंग को समाप्त करने के नाडा के सतत प्रयासों को आगे बढ़ा रहे हैं। इस संहिता में नाडा को "भारत द्वारा नामित ऐसा निकाय जिसके पास संपूर्ण रूप से राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर डोपिंग रोधी नियमों को स्वीकार करने और लागू करने, नमूनों का संग्रहण करने का निदेश देने, जांच परिणामों का प्रबंधन करने और सुनवाई आयोजित करने का सर्वोच्च अधिकार है" के रूप में परिभाषित किया गया है।

डोपिंग रोधी कार्यक्रमों का उद्देश्य उन बातों को परिरक्षित करना है जो खेल के लिए मूल रूप से मूल्यवान हों। इस मूलभूत मूल्य को प्राय "खेल की भावना" कहा जाता है; ओलंपिक खेलों का मूल सार भी यही है; इसी प्रकार हम सद्भावना से खेल खेलते हैं। प्रतिस्पर्धा नियमों की तरह ये डोपिंग रोधी नियम उन दशाओं को शासित करने वाले खेल नियम हैं जिनके तहत खेल खेले जाते हैं। खेलों में भाग लेने वाले खिलाड़ी इन नियमों को खेलों में सहभागिता की शर्तों के रूप में स्वीकार करते हैं और ये इन नियमों द्वारा बाध्य होते हैं। वास्तव में डोपिंग खेल की भावना के विरुद्ध है।

पृष्ठभूमि:

अंतर्राष्ट्रीय ओलंपिक समिति (आईओसी), यूनेस्को समझौते के अनुसार, 1999 में विश्व डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी के गठन से पहले खेलों के संवर्धन और खेलों में डोपिंग को रोकने के लिए जिम्मेदार थी।

खेलों में डोपिंग पर प्रथम विश्व सम्मेलन 1999 के प्रारंभ में लाउसेन, स्वीटजरलैंड में आयोजित किया गया था जिसके परिणामस्वरूप 1999 के अंत में विश्व डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (वाडा) का सृजन किया गया। भारत सरकार विश्व डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (वाडा) (1999–2002) का एक संस्थापक सदस्य है। वाडा, जो खेलों में डोपिंग के विरुद्ध अभियान में मानक निर्धारित करता है, ने 05 मार्च, 2003 को कोपनहेगन, डेनमार्क में वाडा संहिता को अंगीकार किया।

राष्ट्र पक्षकारों में से एक, भारत ने दिसंबर, 2004 में कोपनहेगन डोपिंग रोधी घोषणा पर हस्ताक्षर किए। उक्त संहिता के संदर्भ में राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (नाडा) को 24.11.2005 को सोसायटी के रूप में पंजीकृत किया गया। 2007 में, मैड्रिड, स्पेन में तीसरा विश्व सम्मेलन आयोजित किया गया जिसमें संहिता के स्वरूप में संशोधन किया गया। कोपनहेगन डोपिंग रोधी घोषणा और यूनेस्को डोपिंग रोधी अंतर्राष्ट्रीय समझौते (01 फरवरी, 2007) के पक्षकार के रूप में, नाडा ने 07 मार्च, 2008 को विश्व डोपिंग रोधी संहिता स्वीकार की और वाडा संहिता के अनुरूप नाडा के डोपिंग रोधी नियम (एडीआर) तैयार किए।

राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी कार्यक्रम

भारत सरकार द्वारा राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (नाडा) की स्थापना भारत के लिए स्वतंत्र डोपिंग रोधी संगठन के रूप में कार्य करने के उद्देश्य से की गई थी। नाडा के पास निम्नलिखित कार्यों का आवश्यक प्राधिकार और जिम्मेदारी है:

- डोपिंग नियंत्रण में सुधारों की योजना बनाना, समन्वय करना, कार्यान्वयन करना, निगरानी करना और उनका प्रसार करना;
- अन्य संगत राष्ट्रीय संगठनों, एजेंसियों और अन्य डोपिंग रोधी संगठनों के साथ सहयोग करना;
- राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी संगठनों के बीच परस्पर जांच को प्रोत्साहित करना;
- डोपिंग रोधी अनुसंधान का संवर्धन करना;
- जहां वित्त पोषण प्रदान किया जाता है, उन मामलों में ऐसे किसी भी एथलीट या एथलीट सहायक कार्मिक, जिसने डोपिंग रोधी नियमों का उल्लंघन किया है, को उसकी अयोग्यता की किसी भी अवधि के दौरान कुछ या संपूर्ण वित्तीय सहायता को रोकना;
- क्या एथलीट सहायक कार्मिक या अन्य कार्मिक डोपिंग के प्रत्येक मामले में शामिल हैं, इसकी जांच करने सहित अपने क्षेत्राधीकार में आने वाले डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के सभी संभावित उल्लंघनों पर तत्परता से कार्रवाई करना;
- डोपिंग रोधी सूचना और शिक्षा कार्यक्रमों की योजना बनाना, उसे कार्यान्वित करना और उसकी निगरानी करना।

प्रबंधन

नाडा को 1890 के सोसायटी पंजीकरण अधिनियम के तहत एक पंजीकृत सोसायटी के रूप में स्थापित किया गया और इसने 01 जनवरी, 2009 से कार्य करना शुरू किया। नाडा का प्रबंधन और इसके कार्य शासी निकाय में निहित हैं जिसके अध्यक्ष युवा कार्यक्रम और खेल मंत्री, उपाध्यक्ष सचिव (खेल) हैं और इसमें 4 अन्य सदस्य, 2 प्रतिष्ठित वैज्ञानिक और सदस्य सचिव के रूप में नाडा के महानिदेशक हैं। नाडा का पूर्ण वित्त पोषण युवा

कार्यक्रम और खेल मंत्रालय द्वारा अनुदान के माध्यम से किया जा रहा है। नाडा, वाडा के निरंतर समन्वय से कार्य कर रहा है और यह वाडा द्वारा निर्धारित सभी नियमों, प्रक्रियाओं और अंतर्राष्ट्रीय मानकों का पालन करता है। उपरोक्त अधिदेश के अनुसार, नाडा ने न केवल वाडा संहिता को अंगीकार किया है बल्कि इसने अपने भी डोपिंग रोधी नियम भी बनाए, जो 1 जनवरी, 2009 से लागू हुए। ये नियम वाडा संहिता, 2009 के आधार पर संशोधित किए गए हैं।

रोग चिकित्सा प्रयोग छूट (टीयूई): डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के तहत रोग चिकित्सा प्रयोग छूट समिति में ऐसे प्रतिष्ठित और अत्यधिक योग्य चिकित्सा डॉक्टर हैं जिन्हें सामान्य चिकित्सा, फार्माकॉलाजी और छाती रोगों के क्षेत्र में विशेषज्ञता प्राप्त है। इस समिति का मुख्य कार्य ऐसे खिलाड़ियों के आवेदनों, जिनमें निषिद्ध पदार्थ या निषिद्ध विधि का प्रयोग अपेक्षित हो, पर विचार करना है, जो चिकित्सा दशा के आधार पर चिकित्सा उपचार में छूट चाहते हों, समीक्षाधीन वर्ष के दौरान समिति ने छूट के लिए 07 मामलों की जांच की है और 07 मामलों में छूट की सिफारिश की है।

शैक्षिक कार्यक्रम

अप्रैल, 2014 से मार्च, 2015 की अवधि के दौरान, नाडा ने खिलाड़ियों, युवा एथलीटों, कोचों और सहायक स्टॉफ के लिए पूरे देश में 45 शैक्षिक और जागरूकता कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए हैं।

नाडा के तकनीकी अधिकारी भारतीय खेल प्राधिकरण के क्षेत्रीय केंद्रों और अन्य स्थानों (जहां कहीं प्रशिक्षण शिविर आयोजित किए जाते हों) का नियमित रूप से निरीक्षण कर रहे हैं और अंग्रेजी, हिंदी, तमिल, तेलुगू, मलयालम और पंजाबी में मुद्रित डोप नियंत्रण पर लघु पुस्तिकाओं की सहायता से नियमित आधार पर व्याख्यान/सेमिनार/कार्यशालाएं आदि आयोजित करके एथलीटों को खेलों में डोपिंग और डोप के पदार्थों के हानिकारक बुरे प्रभावों के बारे में शिक्षित कर रहे हैं।

बेहतर आउटरीच और जन साधारण तक पहुंच बनाने के लिए, नाडा राष्ट्रीय और क्षेत्रीय स्तरों पर सीबीएससी स्कूलों और भारतीय स्कूल खेल परिसंघ द्वारा आयोजित खेल स्पर्धाओं के माध्यम से डोपिंग रोधी उपायों का समन्वय कर रहा है।

ग्रामीण खेल केंद्रों पर विशेष फोकस देते हुए, भारतीय खेल प्राधिकरण और ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों में इसके प्रशिक्षण केंद्रों (एसटीसी) नामतः पलवल, खरखोदा, जिला सोनीपत (हरियाणा), एसटीसी त्रिंसूर, एसटीसी कालीकट (केरल) और सालेम (तमिलनाडु) में विभिन्न डोपिंग रोधी जागरूकता परिसंवाद और कार्यशालाएं आयोजित की गई हैं। खेल स्पर्धाओं / प्रशिक्षण शिविरों में ग्रामीण और जूनियर स्तर के एथलीटों पर एकाग्र ध्यान देने के लिए शिक्षा सेमिनारों के भाग के रूप में, नाडा ने ग्रामीण एथलीटों पर विशेष ध्यान देने के लिए चेन्नई और कोयंबटूर में खेल स्पर्धाओं के लिए डोपिंग रोधन में आउटरीच कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए।

अंतर्राष्ट्रीय सहयोग

वरिष्ठ परियोजना अधिकारी नाडा ने 4–5 सितंबर, 2013 तक सियोल, कोरिया में आयोजित एशिया में डोपिंग रोधी प्रशासन परिसंवाद में भाग लिया। इस परिसंवाद में सहभागिता से डोपिंग रोधी कार्यक्रम के प्रभावी संचालन के बारे में गहन जानकारी मिली है। इस परिसंवाद में स्टाफ की भूमिका और जिम्मेदारियों को परिभाषित करने की आवश्यकता और उत्तम संचार प्रणाली की आवश्यकता पर बल दिया गया।

महानिदेशक नाडा ने 19–20 सितंबर, 2013 तक पेरिस, फ्रांस में आयोजित खेलों में डोपिंग के विरुद्ध अंतर्राष्ट्रीय समझौते के पक्षकारों के सम्मेलन के चौथे सत्र में भाग लिया।

विश्व डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (वाडा) ने खेल एवं मनोरंजन साउथ अफ्रिका (एसआरएसए) के सहयोग से 12–15 नवंबर, 2013 तक जोहांसबर्ग, साउथ अफ्रिका में खेलों में डोपिंग पर विश्व सम्मेलन आयोजित किया। महानिदेशक नाडा और वरिष्ठ परियोजना अधिकारी नाडा को जोहांसबर्ग, साउथ अफ्रिका में विश्व सम्मेलन में भाग लेने के लिए प्रतिनियुक्त किया गया। खेलों में डोपिंग पर विश्व सम्मेलन का मुख्य फोकस, 2015 संशोधित संहिता, प्रयोगशालाओं के लिए संशोधित अंतर्राष्ट्रीय मानक, निजी और वैयक्तिगत सूचना के संरक्षण हेतु संशोधित अंतर्राष्ट्रीय मानक, रोग चिकित्सा प्रयोग छूट के लिए संशोधित अंतर्राष्ट्रीय मानक और जांच तथा अन्वेषण के लिए अंतर्राष्ट्रीय मानक पर विचार–विमर्श करना और इसका समर्थन करना है।

परियोजना अधिकारी, नाडा ने 27–28 जनवरी, 2014 तक टोकियो, जापान में आयोजित एशिया में 2014 अंतर्राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी सेमिनार में भाग लिया। इस सेमिनार में सहभागिता से नई विश्व डोपिंग रोधी संहिता, 2015 के प्रभावी कार्यान्वयन के बारे में गहन जानकारी मिली है। इस सेमिनार में नई वाडा संहिता, 2015 के अनुसार डोपिंग रोधी नियमों में समय पर संशोधन करने के लिए नाडो/राडो की भूमिका तथा जिम्मेदारियों को परिभाषित करने की आवश्यकता पर बल दिया गया।

CHAPTER

INTRODUCTION

Anti-Doping Rules, like Competition rules, are sport rules governing the conditions under which sport is played. Athletes, Athlete Support Personnel and other Persons accept these rules as a condition of participation and shall be bound by them. These sport specific rules and procedures, aimed at enforcing anti-doping principles in a global and harmonized environment, are distinct in nature. The National Anti Doping Agency [NADA] has accepted the World Anti-Doping Code (the “Code”). These Anti-Doping Rules are adopted and implemented in conformity with the NADA’s responsibilities under the Code, and are in furtherance of NADA’s continuing efforts to eradicate doping in India. The Code defines NADA as “The entity designated by India as possessing the primary authority to adopt and implement anti-doping rules, direct the collection of Samples, the management of test results, and the conduct of hearings, all at the national level.

Anti-doping programmes seek to preserve what is intrinsically valuable about sport. This intrinsic value is often referred to as “the spirit of sport”; it is the essence of Olympism; it is how we play true. These Anti-Doping Rules, like Competition rules, are sports rules governing the conditions under which sport is played. Participants accept these rules as a condition of participation in sport and shall be bound by them. Doping is fundamentally contrary to the spirit of sport.

BACKGROUND:

International Olympic Committee (IOC) was responsible for promotion of sports and along with Anti-Doping in sports prior to the constitution of the World Anti Doping Agency in 1999, in accordance with the UNESCO Convention. The First World Conference on Doping in sports was held in Lausanne, Switzerland in early 1999 and led to the creation of World Anti Doping Agency (WADA) later that year (1999). Government of India is one of the Foundation Members of World Anti Doping Agency (WADA) (1999-

2002). WADA, which sets out standards in the fight against doping in sports, adopted the WADA Code on 5th March 2003 at Copenhagen, Denmark.

India one of the State parties signed the Copenhagen Declaration on Anti Doping in December 2004. In terms of the Code, National Anti Doping Agency (NADA) was registered as a Society on 24.11.2005. In 2007, the Third World Conference was held in Madrid, Spain and culminated in the revised version of the Code. As signatory of Copenhagen Declaration on Anti Doping and UNESCO International Convention against Doping (1st February 2007), NADA accepted the World Anti Doping Code on 7th March 2008 and framed the Anti Doping Rules (ADR) of NADA in conformity with the WADA's code

CHAPTER

NATIONAL ANTI DOPING PROGRAMME

The National Anti Doping Agency [NADA] was established by the Government of India, with the objective of acting as the independent Anti-Doping Organization for India. The NADA has the necessary authority and responsibility for:

- Planning, coordinating, implementing, monitoring and advocating improvements in Doping Control;
- Cooperating with other relevant national organizations, agencies and other Anti-Doping Organizations;
- Encouraging reciprocal Testing between National Anti-Doping Organizations;
- Promoting anti-doping research;
- Where funding is provided, withholding some or all funding, during any period of his or her Ineligibility, to any Athlete or Athlete Support Personnel who has violated anti-doping rules;
- Vigorously pursuing all potential anti-doping rule violations within its jurisdiction including investigating into whether Athlete Support Personnel or other Persons may have been involved in each case of doping.
- Planning, implementing and monitoring anti doping information and education programs.

MANAGEMENT:

NADA was set up as registered society under the Societies Registration Act of 1890 and came into functioning effective from 1st January 2009. The management and the affairs of NADA vest with the Governing Body comprising of Minister for Youth Affairs & Sports as its Chairman, Secretary (Sports), its Vice-Chairman with 4 other Members, 2 Eminent Scientists and a Director General of NADA as Member Secretary. NADA is being funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports by means of grant. NADA has been working in close coordination with WADA and follows all the rules, procedures

and International standards prescribed by WADA. In accordance with the above mandate, NADA has not only adopted WADA Code but also formulated its own Anti Doping Rules, which came into effect from 1st January, 2009. These rules were further amended on the basis of WADA Code, 2009 and the amended rules came into effect from 1st January, 2010.

During the year 2013-14, NADA has collected **4140** Urine and **301** blood samples as per the details below:

Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUEs): Under the ADR, the Therapeutic Use Exemption Committee is consisted of eminent and highly qualified medical practitioners who have expertise in the field of General Medicine, Pharmacology and Chest Diseases. The main function of the Committee is to consider applications of sportspersons who are seeking therapeutic use exemption on the grounds of medical condition requiring use of a prohibited substance or a prohibited method. During the year under report, the Committee has examined **07** cases for exemption and recommended exemption in **07** cases.

CHAPTER

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES

During the period from April 2013 to March 2014, NADA has conducted **45** nos. of educational and awareness programmes across the country for sports persons, young athletes, coaches and supporting staffs.

The technical officials of NADA are regularly visiting Sports Authority of India (SAI) Regional Centres and other places (wherever training camps are held) and educating the athletes on doping in sports and harmful side effects of the dope substances by conducting lectures/seminars/workshops etc. on regular basis with the help of dope control hand books printed in English, Hindi, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam and Punjabi.

To achieve a better outreach and to reach the masses, NADA coordinating in anti-doping measures through sport events organized by CBSE schools and School Games Federation of India both at National and regional levels.

Keeping special focus on rural sports centres various Anti-Doping awareness symposia and workshops have been conducted in the Sports Authority of India (SAI) and SAI training Centres (STC) in rural areas namely Palwal, Kharkhoda, Dist. Sonepat (Haryana), STC Thrissure, STC Calicut (Kerala) and Salem (Tamilnadu). As part of Education seminars to concentrate on rural and junior level athletes at sports events/training camps, NADA conducted Outreach programmes in Anti-Doping for Sports events in Chennai and Coimbatore to give special attention to rural athletes.

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

Senior Project Officer, NADA attended the Anti Doping Administration Symposium in Asia held at **Seoul, Korea** from 4-5 September, 2013. The participation in the Symposium has given an insight about the effective administration of Anti Doping Program. The Symposium emphasized on the need to define the role and responsibilities of staff and the need for good communication system.

Director General, NADA attended the Fourth Session of the Conference of Parties to the International Convention against Doping in Sports held at **Paris, France** from September 19-20, 2013.

The World Anti Doping Agency (WADA) in association with Sport and Recreation South Africa (SRSA) organized the World Conference on Doping in Sport at **Johannesburg, South Africa** from 12-15 November, 2013. The Director General, NADA and Sr. Project Officer, NADA were deputed to attend the World Conference at Johannesburg, South Africa. The main focus of the World conference on Doping in Sport is to discuss and endorse the 2015 Revised Code, the Revised International Standard for Laboratories, the Revised International Standard for Protection of Privacy and Personal Information, the Revised International Standard for Therapeutic Use Exemptions and new International Standard for Testing and Investigations.

Project Officer, NADA attended the 2014 International Anti Doping Seminar in Asia held at **Tokyo, Japan** from 27-28 January, 2014. The participation in the Seminar has given an insight about the effective implementation on New World Anti Doping Code 2015. The Seminar emphasized on the need to define the role and responsibilities of NADO/RADO to timely revise the Anti Doping Rules as per the new WADA Code 2015.

SCHEDULE 24- SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

The financial statements are required to be prepared on the basis of historical cost convention, unless otherwise stated and on the accrual method of accounting.

2. INVENTORY VALUATION

Inventories are valued at lower of cost and of and net realizable value. The costs are based on FIFO basis. Cost of inventory is determined by considering material, labour and related overheads.

3. INVESTMENTS

3.1 Investments classified as “long term investments” are carried at cost. Provisions for decline, other than temporary, is made in carrying cost of such investments.

3.2 Investments classified as “Current” are carried at lower of cost and fair value. Provision for shortfall on the value of such investments is made for each investments considered individually and not on a global basis.

3.3 Cost includes acquisition expenses like brokerage, transfer stamps.

4. FIXED ASSETS

4.1 Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition. In respect of projects involving construction, related pre-operational expenses(including interest on loans for specific project prior to its completion), form part of the value of the assets capitalized.

4.2 Fixed Assets received by way of non-monetary grants, (other than towards the Corpus Fund), are capitalized at values stated, by corresponding credit to Capital Reserve.

5. DEPRECIATION

Depreciation is provided on WDV method as per rates specified in the Income Tax Act, 1961.

6. MISCELLANEOUS EXPENDITURE

Deferred revenue expenditure is written off over a period of 5 years from the year it is incurred.

7. ACCOUNTING FOR SALES

Sales include excise duty and are net of sale returns, rebate and trade discount.

Lease rentals are expensed with reference to lease terms.

11. **RETIREMENTS BENEFITS**

11.1 Liability towards gratuity payable on death/retirement, and, provision of accumulated leave benefits, of employees is accounted on actual basis. Actuarial valuation is not available.

11.2 Payment towards National Pension Scheme is being disclosed as 'NPS Fund' with corresponding investment in Fixed Deposits for the amount of employee contribution and employer's contribution.




