प्रस्तावना

प्रतिस्पर्धा नियमों की तरह डोपिंग रोधी नियम ऐसी दशाओं को शासित करने वाले खेलों के नियम होते हैं, जिनके तहत खेल खेले जाते हैं। एथलीट, एथलीट सहायक कार्मिक और अन्य व्यक्ति भाग लेने की शर्त के रूप में इन नियमों को स्वीकार करते हैं और वे इन नियमों द्वारा बाध्य होंगे। ये खेल विशिष्ट नियम और प्रक्रियाएं, जिनका उद्देश्य वैश्विक और सौहार्दपूर्ण परिवेश में डोपिंग रोधी सिद्धांतों को लागू करना है, सुस्पष्ट होते हैं। राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (नाडा) ने विश्व डोपिंग रोधी संहिता ("संहिता") स्वीकार की है। ये डोपिंग रोधी नियम संहिता के तहत नाडा की जिम्मेदारियों के अनुरूप स्वीकार किए गए हैं और लागू किए गए हैं, और ये भारत में डोपिंग को समाप्त करने के नाडा के सतत प्रयासों को आगे बढ़ा रहे हैं। इस संहिता में नाडा को "भारत द्वारा नामित ऐसा निकाय जिसके पास संपूर्ण रूप से राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर डोपिंग रोधी नियमों को स्वीकार करने और लागू करने, नमूनों का संग्रहण करने का निदेश देने, जांच परिणामों का प्रबंधन करने और सुनवाई आयोजित करने का सर्वोच्च अधिकार है" के रूप में परिभाषित किया गया है।

पृष्ठभूमि:

खेलों में डोपिंग पर प्रथम विश्व सम्मेलन 1999 के प्रारंभ में लाउसेन, स्वीट्जरलैंड में आयोजित किया गया था जिसके परिणामस्वरूप 1999 के अंत में विश्व डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (वाडा) का सृजन किया गया। भारत सरकार विश्व डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (वाडा) (1999–2002) का एक संस्थापक सदस्य है। वाडा, जो खेलों में डोपिंग के विरुद्ध अभियान में मानक निर्धारित करता है, ने 05 मार्च, 2003 को कोपनहेगन, डेनमार्क में वाडा संहिता को अंगीकार किया।

राष्ट्र पक्षकारों में से एक, भारत ने दिसंबर, 2004 में कोपनहेगन डोपिंग रोधी घोषणा पर हस्ताक्षर किए। उक्त संहिता के संदर्भ में राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (नाडा) को 24.11.2005 को सोसायटी के रूप में पंजीकृत किया गया। 2007 में मैड्रिड, स्पेन में तीसरा विश्व सम्मेलन आयोजित किया गया जिसमें संहिता के स्वरूप में संशोधन किया गया। कोपनहेगन

डोपिंग रोधी घोषणा और यूनेस्को डोपिंग रोधी अंतर्राष्ट्रीय समझौते (01 फरवरी, 2007) के पक्षकार के रूप में, नाडा ने 07 मार्च, 2008 को विश्व डोपिंग रोधी संहिता स्वीकार की और वाडा संहिता के अनुरूप नाडा के डोपिंग रोधी नियम (एडीआर) तैयार किए।

राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी कार्यक्रम

भारत सरकार द्वारा राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी की स्थापना भारत के लिए स्वतंत्र डोपिंग रोधी संगठन के रूप में कार्य करने के उद्देश्य से की गई थी। नाडा के पास निम्नलिखित कार्यों का आवश्यक प्राधिकार और जिम्मेदारी है:

- डोपिंग नियंत्रण में सुधारों की योजना बनाना, समन्वय करना, कार्यान्वयन करना, निगरानी करना और उनका प्रसार करना;
- अन्य संगत राष्ट्रीय संगठनों, एजेंसियों और अन्य डोपिंग रोधी संगठनों के साथ सहयोग करना;
- राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी संगठनों के बीच परस्पर जांच को प्रोत्साहित करना;
- डोपिंग रोधी अनुसंधान का संवर्धन करना;
- जहां वित्त पोषण प्रदान किया जाता है, उन मामलों में ऐसे किसी भी एथलीट या एथलीट सहायक कार्मिक, जिसने डोपिंग रोधी नियमों का उल्लंघन किया है, को उसकी अयोग्यता की किसी भी अवधि के दौरान कुछ या संपूर्ण वित्तीय सहायता को रोकना;
- क्या एथलीट सहायक कार्मिक या अन्य कार्मिक डोपिंग के प्रत्येक मामले में शामिल हैं, इसकी जांच करने सहित अपने क्षेत्राधीकार में आने वाले डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के सभी संभावित उल्लंघनों पर तत्परता से कार्रवाई करना;
- डोपिंग रोधी सूचना और शिक्षा की योजना बनाना, उसे कार्यान्वयन करना और उसकी निगरानी करना।

इस प्रकार नाडा, अनुशासनीक प्राधिकारियों (डोपिंग रोधी अनुशासनीक पैनल और डोपिंग रोधी अपील पैनल) से अलग एक विशिष्ट निकाय है

नाडा के लिए गुणवत्तापरक प्रबंधन प्रणाली का कार्यान्वयन

नाडा ने आईएसओ 9001: 2008 प्रमाणान प्राप्त करने की प्रक्रिया पूरी कर ली है। गुणवत्तापरक प्रबंधन प्रणाली (आईएसओ 9001: 2008) के कार्यान्वयन से, डोप नमूना

सग्रहण, परिणाम प्रबंधन और शिक्षा एवं प्रशिक्षण के कार्यकलाप प्रमाणन दायरे के तहत आ गए हैं। प्रमाणन का उद्देश्य डोपिंग रोधी कार्यक्रम को सुदृढ़ करना और निम्नलिखित उद्देश्य प्राप्त करना है:

- देश में सभी खेल संगठनों द्वारा पालन कराए जाने हेतु डोपिंग रोधी सहिता लागू करना।
- सभी सहभागी हितधारकों के माध्यम से डोप जांच कार्यक्रम का समन्वय करना।
- डोप मुक्त खेलों के महत्व की समझ पैदा करने के लिए डोपिंग रोधी अनुसाधन और शिक्षा का सर्वधन करना।
- कार्यक्रम के प्रभावी कार्यान्वयन और सतत सुधार को आसान बनाने के लिए सर्वोत्तम प्रक्रिया मानक और गुणवत्ता प्रणालियां अपनाना।

डोपिंग रोधी नियमों का कार्यान्वयन:

राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी संगठन के रूप में नाडा, वाडा सहिता के अनुरूप डोपिंग रोधी नियमों का कार्यान्वयन करने के लिए जिम्मेदार है। ये डोपिंग रोधी नियम ऐसी दशाओं को गासित करने वाले नियम हैं, जिनके तहत खेल खेला जाता है। ये डोपिंग रोधी नियम नाडा पर लागू होंगे। इन डोपिंग रोधी नियमों को अपनाकर और इन्हें गासी दस्तावेजों और खेल के नियमों में समाविट करके, रा ट्रीय परिसंघ, रा ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी कार्यक्रम कार्यान्वयन करने और डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के अनुच्छेद 1.3 में सूचीबद्ध ऐसे सभी व्यक्तियों जो रा ट्रीय परिसंघ के क्षेत्राधिकार में आते हैं, के संबंध में इन डोपिंग रोधी नियमों (जांच करने सहित) को लागू करने के लिए नाडा का प्राधिकार और जिम्मेदारी स्वीकार करते हैं और ये उक्त कार्य में नाडा को सहयोग करेंगे और सहायता देंगे। ये रा ट्रीय परिसंघ सुनवाई पैनलों के निर्णयों, जिनसे उनके क्षेत्राधिकार में आने वाले व्यक्तियों पर प्रतिबंध लगाए जाते हैं, सहित इन डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के अनुसरण में दिए गए निर्णयों को भी स्वीकार करेंगे, उनका पालन करेंगे और उन्हें लागू करेंगे।

नाडा 2015 के संशोधित डोपिंग रोधी नियम:

नाडा, वाडा के निरंतर समन्वय से कार्य कर रहा है और यह वाडा द्वारा निर्धारित सभी नियमों, प्रक्रियाओं और अंतर्राष्ट्रीय मानकों का पालन करता है। उपरोक्त अध्यादेश के अनुसार, नाडा ने न केवल वाडा संहिता को अंगीकार किया है बल्कि इसने अपने ही डोपिंग रोधी नियमों में भी संशोधन किया है। ये नियम वाडा संहिता, 2015 के आधार पर संशोधित किए गए हैं और संशोधित नियम 01 जनवरी, 2015 से प्रभावी हुए।

डोप नमूना संग्रहण:

वर्ष 2015–16 के दौरान, नाडा का लक्ष्य मूत्र के 5000 नमूने और रक्त के 300 नमूने लेने का लक्ष्य था। और नाडा ने समूचे भारत में स्थित अपने पैनल में दर्ज डोपिंग नियंत्रण अधिकारियों की सहायता से मूत्र के 4669 नमूने और रक्त के 277 नमूने लिए है। एथलीटों के ये नमूने पूरे भारत में आयोजित विभिन्न चैम्पियनशिपों में और भारतीय खेल प्राधिकरण द्वारा अपने कंट्रो और अन्य खेल निकायों द्वारा आयोजित प्रशिक्षण शिविरों के दौरान लिए गए जिनका ब्यौरा इस प्रकार है:

डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के उल्लंघन का परिणाम प्रबंधन:

चिकित्सा उपचार प्रयोग छूट (टीयूई): डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के तहत रोग चिकित्सा प्रयोग छूट समिति में ऐसे प्रतिष्ठित और अत्यधिक योग्य चिकित्सा डॉक्टर है जिन्हें सामान्य चिकित्सा, फार्माकॉलाजी और हड्डी रोगों के क्षेत्र में विशेषज्ञता प्राप्त है। इस समिति का मुख्य कार्य ऐसे खिलाडियों के आवेदनों पर विचार करना है, जो चिकित्सा दशा के आधार पर चिकित्सा उपचार में छूट चाहते हों, जिनमें निषिद्ध पदार्थ या निषिद्ध विधि का प्रयोग अपेक्षित हो। वर्ष के दौरान समिति ने छूट के लिए मुक्केबाजी और भारोत्तोलन खेल विधाओं के 02 मामलों की जांच की है।

डोपिंग रोधी नियमों का उल्लंघन:

वर्ष 2015–16 में, कुल 92 एथलीटों / खिलाडियों को नाडा के डोपिंग रोधी नियमों का उल्लंघन करते हुए पाया गया है।

डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के उल्लंघन के मामलों के संबंध में निष्पक्ष तरीके से सुनवाई आयोजित करने के लिए 1.001 जनवरी, 2009 से नाडा के डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के तहत दो पैनलों नामतः डोपिंग रोधी अनुशासनिक पैनल (एडीडीपी) और डोपिंग रोधी अपील पैनल (एडीएपी) गठित किए गए हैं। इस पैनल का गठन डोपिंग रोधी नियम 2015 के अनुच्छेद 8 और अनुच्छेद 13 के अनुसार किया गया है।

डोपिंग रोधी अनुशासनिक पैनल:

इस पैनल के अध्यक्ष सेवानिवृत्त जिला एवं सत्र न्यायधीश हैं और इसके सदस्य कानून, चिकित्सा, खेल क्षेत्र के प्रतिष्ठित व्यक्ति हैं। 2015-16 के दौरान, पैनल ने 62 बैठकें की हैं और इसे सौंपे गए 119 मामलों में सुनवाई की है। विगत वर्षों में सौंपे गए लिंगित मामलों सहित कुल 83 मामलों का निर्णय किया गया और एथलीटों पर प्रतिबंध लगाए गए। अन्य मामले सुनवाई के विभिन्न चरणों में हैं।

हैं। 2015–16 के दौरान, पैनल ने 08 बैठकें की और 10 मामलों का निर्णय किया।

पीईएडीएस - शिक्षा और जागरूकता

नाडा का आईईसी अभियान देश में डोपिंग के खतरे को दूर करने के लिए तैयार किया गया है। इसकी योजना यह है कि प्रतिस्पर्धी खिलाड़ियों में डोपिंग रोधी उपायों का जागरूकता स्तर बढ़ाया जाए और इस प्रकार डोपिंग के खतरे को आगे बढ़ने से रोका जाए। इस समय, जागरूकता का स्तर राष्ट्रीय स्तर के खिलाड़ियों में अपेक्षाकृत ज्यादा है। तथापि, यह जागरूकता उभरते एथलीटों में कम है। आईईसी अभियान योजना से हितधारकों में और अधिक जागरूकता पैदा करने में सहायता मिल सकती है।

पिछले पांच वर्षों में, नाडा ने डोप के लिए मूत्र के 20000 से अधिक नमूने लिए हैं जिनमें से 700 नमूनों में एथलीटों को डोप पॉजीटिव पाया गया। डोप पॉजीटिव एथलीटों में, एथलैटिक्स, भारोत्तोलन, कुश्ती, पावर लिफ्टिंग, कबड्डी, मुक्केबाजी आदि जैसी खेल विधाओं में इन मामलों की संख्या काफी अधिक है। इसे ध्यान में रखते हुए, जागरूकता अभियान को उपरोक्त विधाओं पर और अधिक फोकस किए जाने की आवश्यकता है।

इस डोपिंग रोधी अभियान के जागरूकता—सह—आउटरीच स्तर को बढ़ाने के लिए, संपूर्ण भारत में इलेक्ट्रॉनिक, प्रिंट मीडिया और आउटडोर प्रचार के इस्तेमाल पर और अधिक बल दिए जाने की आवश्यकता है। इससे नाडा ने विभिन्न हितधारकों के लिए प्रस्तुति सामग्री और प्रशिक्षण माड्चूल का विकास करना शुरू किया है। इसके अलावा, इस अभियान के लिए ऑडियो विजुअल सामग्री अर्थात् डोपिंग रोधन पर लघु फिल्में, वृत्तचित्र वीडियों स्पोट का इस्तेमाल किया जाएगा।

उपरोक्त को देखते हुए जागरूकता कार्यक्रम/कार्यशालाएं तथा प्रशिक्षण माड्चूल आयोजित करने की योजना के लिए संभावित वित्तीय भार का आकलन किया गया है और इस पहल "खेलों में डोपिंग रोधन पर शिक्षा और जागरूकता कार्यक्रम (पीईएडीएस) नाम दिया गया है। इसके उद्देश्य इस प्रकार हैं:

कार्यक्रम के उद्देश्य:

- प्रतिस्पर्धी खिलाड़ियों तथा अन्य सभी हितधारकों में डोपिंग रोधी जागरूकता पैदा करना।

- सभी हितधारकों को डोपिंग रोधी उपायों संबंधी सूचना उपलब्ध कराना।
- खेल संस्थानों/परिसंघों/एसोसिएशनों/विश्वविद्यालयों/कॉलेजों के माध्यम से जागरूकता / प्रशिक्षण कार्यशाला आयोजित करना।
- चिकित्सा डॉक्टरों और सहायक कार्मिकों के लिए निषेध पदार्थों/विधियों पर सतत चिकित्सा शिक्षा (सीएमई) आयोजित करना।

नाडा, भारतीय खेल प्राधिकारण (एसएआई), राष्ट्रीय डोप जांच प्रयोगशाला (एनडीटीएल) और भारतीय खेल परिसंघ के बाद मुख्य हितधारक है, और यह सभी सहभागी हितधारकों के सहयोग से भारत के विभिन्न भागों में जागरूकता कार्यक्रम आयोजित कर रहा है। समीक्षाधीन अवधि के दौरान, खिलाड़ियों, युवा एथलीटों, कोचों और सहायक स्टॉफ के लिए पूरे देश में सहभागी हितधारकों के सहयोग से कुल 55 शैक्षिक और जागरूकता कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए गए हैं।

नाडा के अधिकारी विशेषज्ञों के साथ भारतीय खेल प्राधिकरण के क्षेत्रीय केंद्रों और अन्य स्थानों (जहां कहीं प्रशिक्षण शिविर आयोजित किए जाते हों) का नियमित रूप से निरीक्षण कर रहे हैं और नियमित आधार पर व्याख्यान/सेमिनार/कार्यशालाएं आदि आयोजित करके एथलीटों को खेलों में डोपिंग और डोप के नशीले पदार्थों के हानिकारक बुरे प्रभावों के बारे में शिक्षित कर रहे हैं। इसके अलावा, नाडा द्वारा डोपिंग रोधी ब्रॉशरों / सूचना

CHAPTER

INTRODUCTION

Anti-Doping Rules, like Competition rules, are sport rules governing the conditions under which sport is played. Athletes, Athlete Support Personnel and other Persons accept these rules as a condition of participation and shall be bound by them. These sport specific rules and procedures, aimed at enforcing anti-doping principles in a global and harmonized environment, are distinct in nature. The National Anti Doping Agency [NADA] has accepted the World Anti-Doping Code (the “Code”). These Anti-Doping Rules are adopted and implemented in conformity with the NADA’s responsibilities under the Code, and are in furtherance of NADA’s continuing efforts to eradicate doping in India. The Code defines NADA as “The entity designated by India as possessing the primary authority to adopt and implement anti-doping rules, direct the collection of Samples, the management of test results, and the conduct of hearings, all at the national level.

BACKGROUND:

The First World Conference on Doping in sports was held in Lausanne, Switzerland in early 1999 and led to the creation of World Anti Doping Agency (WADA) later that year (1999). Government of India is one of the Foundation Members of World Anti Doping Agency (WADA) (1999-2002). WADA, which sets out standards in the fight against doping in sports, adopted the WADA Code on 5th March 2003 at Copenhagen, Denmark.

India one of the State parties signed the Copenhagen Declaration on Anti Doping in December 2004. In terms of the Code, National Anti Doping Agency (NADA) was registered as a Society on 24.11.2005. In 2007, the Third World Conference was held in Madrid, Spain and culminated in the revised version of the Code. As signatory of Copenhagen Declaration on Anti Doping and UNESCO International Convention against Doping (1st February 2007), NADA accepted the World Anti Doping Code on 7th March 2008 and framed the Anti Doping Rules (ADR) of NADA in conformity with the WADA’s code.

NATIONAL ANTI DOPING PROGRAMME

The National Anti Doping Agency was established by the Government of India, with the objective of acting as the independent Anti-Doping Organization for India. The NADA has the necessary authority and responsibility for:

- Planning, coordinating, implementing, monitoring and advocating improvements in Doping Control;
- Cooperating with other relevant national organizations, agencies and other Anti-Doping Organizations;
- Encouraging reciprocal Testing between National Anti-Doping Organizations;
- Promoting anti-doping research;
- Where funding is provided, withholding some or all funding, during any period of his or her Ineligibility, to any Athlete or Athlete Support Personnel who has violated anti-doping rules;
- Pursuing all potential anti-doping rule violations within its jurisdiction including investigating into whether Athlete Support Personnel or other Persons may have been involved in each case of doping.
- Planning, implementing and monitoring anti doping information and education programs.

The NADA thereby is a distinct body, independent from the disciplinary authorities (the Anti-Doping Disciplinary Panel and Anti-Doping Appeal Panel).

IMPLEMENTATION OF QUALITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR NADA

NADA has successfully completed the process of obtaining the ISO 9001:2008 Certification. With the implementation of quality management system (ISO 9001: 2008), the activities covering dope sample collection, result management, and education & training are under the scope of the certification. The objective of the certification is to strengthen the Anti Doping Program and to accomplish the following objectives:



- To implement the Anti Doping Code to achieve compliance by all sports organizations in the Country.
- To coordinate dope testing program through all participating stakeholders.
- To promote anti doping research and education to inculcate the value of dope free sports.
- To adopt best practice standards and quality systems to enable effective implementation and continual improvement of the program.

IMPLEMENTATION OF ANTI DOPING RULES:

NADA as a National Anti Doping Organization is responsible for implementing the Anti Doping Rule in line with the WADA Code. These Anti-Doping Rules are rules governing the conditions under which sport is played. These Anti-Doping Rules shall apply to NADA. By adopting these Anti-Doping Rules, and incorporating them into their governing documents and rules of sport, *National Federations* recognize the authority and responsibility of NADA for implementing the National Anti-Doping Program and enforcing these Anti-Doping Rules (including carrying out *Testing*) in respect of all of the *Persons* listed in Article 1.3 of the Anti Doping Rules who are under the jurisdiction of the *National Federation*, and shall cooperate with and support NADA in that function. They shall also recognize, abide by and give effect to the decisions made pursuant to these Anti-Doping Rules, including the decisions of hearing panels imposing sanctions on individuals under their jurisdiction.

REVISED ANTI DOPING RULES OF NADA 2015:

NADA has been working in close coordination with WADA and follows all the rules, procedures and International standards prescribed by WADA. In accordance with the above mandate, NADA has adopted WADA Code 2015 and revised its Anti Doping Rules 2010 in line with WADA Code 2015. These amended Anti Doping Rules was notified as National Anti Doping Rules, India and came into effect from 1st January, 2015.

DOPE SAMPLE COLLECTION

During the year 2015-16, the target of NADA was to collect 5000 urine samples and 300 blood samples and NADA has collected 4669 Urine and 277 blood samples with

the help of its empanelled Doping Control Officers located all over India. The samples of athletes were collected in various championships held all across India and during the training camps organized by Sports Authority of India centers and other sports bodies, as per the details mentioned below:

RESULT MANAGEMENT OF ANTI DOPING RULE VIOLATION

Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUEs): Under the ADR, the Therapeutic Use Exemption Committee consists of eminent and highly qualified medical practitioners who have expertise in the field of General Medicine, Pharmacology and Orthopedics diseases. The main function of the Committee is to consider applications of sportspersons who are seeking therapeutic use exemption on the grounds of medical condition requiring use of a prohibited substance or a prohibited method. During the year, the Committee has examined **02** cases belonging to Boxing and Weightlifting sports discipline for exemption.

ANTI DOPING RULE VIOLATIONS:

In the year 2015 -16, total **92** athletes/sportspersons are found to violate the Anti Doping Rules of NADA.

To conduct fair hearings in an impartial way in regard to cases of Anti Doping Rule violation, two Panels namely, Anti Doping Disciplinary Panel (**ADDP**) and Anti Doping Appeal Panel (**ADAP**) have been constituted since 1st January 2009 under the Anti Doping Rules of NADA. The Panel has been constituted as per Article 8 and Article 13 of Anti Doping Rules 2015.

The Anti Doping Disciplinary Panel:

The panel is headed by retired District and Session Judge and the members are eminent persons from legal, medical, sports field. During the year 2015 -16 the Panel had held **62** sittings and heard **119** cases referred to them. Total **83** cases were decided including pending cases referred in past years and the athletes were issued with sanctions. The other cases are at various stages of hearing.

CHAPTER

PEADS - EDUCATION AND AWARENESS

IEC Campaign of NADA is structured to address the doping menace in the Country. The plan is to increase the awareness level on anti doping measures among competing sportsperson and thereby preventing the spread of doping menace. At present the level of awareness is relatively acceptable with national level players. However, the awareness is low in budding athletes. The IEC Campaign plan can help in creating more awareness among the stakeholders.

In the past five years, NADA has collected more than 20,000 dope urine samples of which 700 samples were found to be dope positive athletes. Among the dope positives, the sports disciplines like athletics, weightlifting, wrestling, power lifting, kabaddi, boxing etc. constitutes significant number of cases. Keeping this in view, the awareness campaign needs to be more focused for the above mentioned disciplines.

To increase the awareness-cum-outreach level of this anti doping campaign, more emphasis on the use of electronic, print media and outdoor publicity across the India is needed. With this NADA has initiated developing of presentation materials and training modules for various stakeholders. In addition audio visual materials viz., small films, documentaries and video spots on anti doping will be used for this campaign.

In view of the above, a plan for conducting awareness programs/workshops along with the training modules and the initiative has been named as "**Program for Education and Awareness on Anti Doping in Sports**" (PEADS) with the following objectives

Objectives of the program:

- To create anti doping awareness among competing sportspersons and all other stakeholders.
- To provide information on anti doping measures to all stakeholders.

- To organize awareness/training workshops through sports institutions/ federations/ associations/universities/colleges.
- To conduct Continuing Medical Education (CME) on prohibited substances/methods for medical doctors and supporting personnel.

NADA being the main stakeholder followed by Sports Authority of India (SAI), National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) and National Sports Federation and in association with all participating stakeholders conducting awareness programs at various parts of India. During the period, a total of 55 nos. of educational and awareness programs have been conducted in association with the participating stakeholders across the country for sports persons, young athletes, coaches and supporting staffs.

The officials of NADA along with the experts for the program regularly visiting Sports Authority of India (SAI) Regional Centers and other places (wherever training camps are held) and educating the athletes on doping in sports and harmful side effects of the dope substances by conducting lectures/seminars/workshops etc. on regular basis. In addition, the anti doping brochures/information got translated and printed by NADA in 14 different languages viz. Hindi, English, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Bengali, Assamese, Gujarati, Marathi, Oriya, Kashmiri and Manipuri languages to ensure



the best communication of anti doping amongst the athlete group belonging to various part of India.

NADA has also organized a one day **Seminar on “Anti Doping Rules of NADA 2015 and Way Forward”** in New Delhi on 16 September 2015 with the members of the Anti Doping Disciplinary Panel/ Anti Doping Appeal Panel and medical personnel of Sports Authority of India/ National Sports Federations and other Sports Bodies. The main objective of the Seminar was to highlight the salient changes incorporated in the Anti Doping Rules of NADA 2015 in line with the WADA Code 2015.

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

- Dr. Saravana Perumal S., Senior Project Officer, along with Mr. B. J. Verma, Assistant Project Officer, NADA visited Canberra, Australia in August 2015 to attend the joint meeting with NADA – WADA – Australian Sports Anti Doping Authority (ASADA) officials to formulate joint project for development of anti-doping program and for the possible scope of partnership to adopt and implement the best practice in dope testing, RTP-Whereabouts Program and Athlete Biological Passport (ABP).

SCHEDULE 24- SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

The financial statements are required to be prepared on the basis of historical cost convention, unless otherwise stated and on the accrual method of accounting.

2. INVENTORY VALUATION

Inventories are valued at lower of cost and of and net realizable value. The costs are based on FIFO basis. Cost of inventory is determined by considering material, labour and related overheads.

3. INVESTMENTS

3.1 Investments classified as “long term investments” are carried at cost. Provisions for decline, other than temporary, is made in carrying cost of such investments.

3.2 Investments classified as “Current” are carried at lower of cost and fair value. Provision for shortfall on the value of such investments is made for each investments considered individually and not on a global basis.

3.3 Cost includes acquisition expenses like brokerage, transfer stamps.

4. FIXED ASSETS

4.1 Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition. In respect of projects involving construction, related pre-operational expenses (including interest on loans for specific project prior to its completion), form part of the value of the assets capitalized.

4.2 Fixed Assets received by way of non-monetary grants, (other than towards the Corpus Fund), are capitalized at values stated, by corresponding credit to Capital Reserve.

5. DEPRECIATION

Depreciation is provided on WDV method as per rates specified in the Income Tax Act, 1961.

6. MISCELLANEOUS EXPENDITURE

Deferred revenue expenditure is written off over a period of 5 years from the year it is incurred.

7. ACCOUNTING FOR SALES

Sales include excise duty and are net of sale returns, rebate and trade discount.

8. GOVERNMENT GRANTS/SUBSIDIES

Government grants of the nature of contribution towards capital is disclosed as endowment fund.

9. FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSACTION

9.1 Transaction denominated in foreign currency are accounted at the exchange rate prevailing at the date of the transaction.

9.2 Current assets, foreign currency loans and current liabilities are converted at the exchange rate prevailing as at the year end and the resultant gain/loss is adjusted to cost of fixed assets, if the foreign currency liability relates to fixed assets, and in other cases is considered to revenue.

10. LEASE

Lease rentals are expensed with reference to lease terms.



11. RETIREMENTS BENEFITS


