अध्याय

प्रस्तावना

राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी (नाडा) ने विश्व डोपिंग रोधी संहिता ("संहिता") स्वीकार की है। ये डोपिंग रोधी नियम, संहिता के तहत नाडा की जिम्मेदारियों के अनुरूप स्वीकार किए गए हैं और लागू किए गए हैं, और ये भारत में डोपिंग को पूर्णतः समाप्त करने के नाडा के सतत प्रयासों को आगे बढ़ा रहे हैं। इस संहिता में नाडा को "भारत द्वारा नामित ऐसा निकाय जिसके पास संपूर्ण रूप से राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर डोपिंग रोधी नियमों को स्वीकार करने और लागू करने, नमूनों का संग्रहणत्र करने का निदेश देने, जांच परिणामों का प्रबंधन करने और सुनवाई आयोजित करने का सर्वोच्च अधिकार है" के रूप में परिभाषित किया गया है।

अध्याय **2**

राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी कार्यक्रम

भारत सरकार द्वारा राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी एजेंसी की स्थापना भारत के लिए स्वतंत्र डोपिंग रोधी संगठन के रूप में कार्य करने के उद्देश्य से की गई थी। नाडा के पास निम्नलिखित कार्यों का आवश्यक प्राधिकार और जिम्मेदारी है:

- डोपिंग नियंत्रण में सुधारों की योजना बनाना, समन्वय करना, कार्यान्वयन करना, निगरानी करना और उनका प्रसार करना;
- अन्य संगत राष्ट्रीय संगठनों, एजेंसियों और अन्य डोपिंग रोधी संगठनों के साथ सहयोग करना;
- राष्ट्रीय डोपिंग रोधी संगठनों के बीच परस्पर जांच को प्रोत्साहित करना;
- डोपिंग रोधी अनुसंधान का संवर्धन करना;
- क्या एथलीट सहायक कार्मिक या अन्य कार्मिक डोपिंग के प्रत्येक मामले में शामिल हैं इसकी जांच करने सहित अपने क्षेत्राधिकार में आने वाले डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के सभी संभावित उल्लंघनों पर तत्परता से कार्रवाई करना;
- डोपिंग रोधी सूचना और शिक्षा की योजना बनाना, उसे कार्यान्वित करना और उसकी निगरानी करना।

इस प्रकार नाडा, अनुशासनिक प्राधिकारियों (डोपिंग रोधी अनुशासनिक पैनल और डोपिंग रोधी अपील पैनल) से अलग एक विशिष्ट निकाय है

डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के उल्लंघन का परिणाम प्रबंधनः

डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के उल्लंघन के मामलों के संबंध में निष्पक्ष तरीके में सुनवाई करने के लिए, 01 जनवरी, 2009 से नाडा के डोपिंग रोधी नियमों के तहत दो पैनलों नामतः

डोपिंग रोधी अनुशासनिक पैनल (एडीडीपी) और डोपिंग रोधी अपील पैनल (एडीएपी) गठित किए गए हैं। इस पैनल का गठन डोपिंग रोधी नियम 2015 के अनुछेद 8 और अनुछेद 13 के अनुसार किया गया है।

परिणाम प्रबंधन प्रक्रिया के दौरान एथिलट द्वारा डोपिंग रोधी नियम के उल्लंघन में अन्तर्निहित सामान्य मुद्दों पर विचार—विमर्श करने के लिए नाडा द्वारा 25.10.2016 को हाल के रूझानों के विशलेषण और डोपिंग रोधी नियम के उल्लंघन के मामले — नाडा के डोपिंग रोधी नियम 2015 पर डोपिंग रोधी पैनल के सदस्यों की परस्पर वार्ता बैठक आयोजित की गई।

डोपिंग रोधी अनुशासनिक पैनलः

इस पैनल के अध्यक्ष सेवानिवृत्त जिला एवं सत्र न्यायधीश हैं और इसके सदस्य कानून, चिकित्सा, और खेल क्षेत्र के व्यक्ति हैं। वर्ष 2016—17 के दौरान पैनल ने 76 बैठके की। विगत वर्षों में लिम्बत मामलों सिहत कुल 71 मामलों में निर्णय किया गया और एथलीटों पर लागू प्रतिबंध लगाए गए। शेष मामलों में सुनवाई की जा रही है।

डोपिंग रोधी अपील पैनल

इस पैनल में अध्यक्ष उच्च न्यायलय के सेवानिवृत्त न्यायधीश और उच्चतम न्यायालय के विरष्ट अधिवक्ता हैं जो अध्यक्ष/उपाध्यक्ष के रूप में कार्य करते हैं और इसके सदस्य चिकित्सा और खेल क्षेत्र के प्रतिष्ठित व्यक्ति हैं। 2016–17 के दौरान पैनल ने 21 बैठके की और 15 मामलों का निर्णय किया।



नाडा, भारतीय खेल प्राधिकारण (एसएआई), राष्ट्रीय डोप जांच प्रयोगशाला (एनडीटीएल) और भारतीय खेल परिसंघ के बाद मुख्य हितधारक है, और यह सभी सहभागी हितधारकों के सहयोग से भारत के विभिन्न भागों में जागरूकता कार्यक्रम आयोजित कर रहा है। समीक्षाधीन अवधि के दौरान, खिलाडियों, युवा एथलीटों, कोचों और सहायक स्टॉफ के लिए पूरे देश में सहभागी हितधारकों के सहयोग से कुल 48 शैक्षिक और जागरूकता कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए गए हैं।

INTRODUCTION

The National Anti Doping Agency [NADA] has accepted the World Anti-Doping Code (the "Code"). These Anti-Doping Rules are adopted and implemented in conformity with the NADA's responsibilities under the Code, and are in furtherance of NADA's continuing efforts to eradicate doping in India. The Code defines NADA as "The entity designated by India as possessing the primary authority to adopt and implement anti-doping rules, direct the collection of Samples, the management of test results, and the conduct of hearings, all at the national level.

NATIONAL ANTI DOPING PROGRAMME

The National Anti Doping Agency was established by the Government of India, with the objective of acting as the independent Anti-Doping Organization for India. The NADA has the necessary authority and responsibility for:

- Planning, coordinating, implementing, monitoring and advocating improvements in Doping Control;
- Cooperating with other relevant national organizations, agencies and other Anti-Doping Organizations;
- Encouraging reciprocal Testing between National Anti-Doping Organizations;
- Promoting anti-doping research;
- Pursuing all potential anti-doping rule violations within its jurisdiction including investigating into whether Athlete Support Personnel or other Persons may have been involved in each case of doping.
- Planning, implementing and monitoring anti doping information and education programs.

The NADA thereby is a distinct body, independent from the disciplinary authorities (the Anti-Doping Disciplinary Panel and Anti-Doping Appeal Panel).

SAMPLE COLLECTION

During the year 2016-17, NADA has collected 3112 dope tests including collecting 224 blood samples during the period with the help of empanelled Doping Control Officers located all over India. The samples of athletes were collected in various championships held all across India and during the training camps organized by Sports Authority of India centers and other sports bodies, as per the details mentioned below:

RESULT MANAGEMENT OF ANTI DOPING RULE VIOLATION

To conduct fair hearings in an impartial way in regard to cases of Anti Doping Rule violation, two Panels namely, Anti Doping Disciplinary Panel (ADDP) and Anti Doping Appeal Panel (ADAP) have been constituted since 1st January 2009 under the Anti Doping Rules of NADA. The Panel has been constituted as per Article 8 and Article 13 of Anti Doping Rules 2015.

An Interaction Meeting of Anti Doping Panel Members on Analysis of Recent Trends and Anti Doping Rule Violation Cases- Anti Doping Rules of NADA 2015 was organized by NADA on 25.10.2016 to discuss the common issues involved in Anti Doping Rule violation cases by athlete during the result management process.

The Anti Doping Disciplinary Panel:

The panel is headed by retired District and Session Judge with members from legal, medical and sports background. During the year 2016 -17 the Panel held **76** sittings. Total **71** cases were decided including pending cases in past years and the athletes were imposed applicable sanctions. The remaining cases are under process of hearing.

The Anti Doping Appeal Panel: The panel is headed by a retired High Court Judge and Sr. Advocate of Supreme Court who acts as Chairman/Vice Chairman and members are eminent persons from medical and sports field. During the year 2016 -17, the Panel had held **21** sittings and decided **15** cases.



A. Books of Accounts

- 1) The Accounts of the agency are maintained on the basis of double entry accounting system as per generally accepted accounting principles.
- 2) Following books of accounts are maintained by the agency:-

a). Bank Book

e). Pay-bill Register

b). Journal

f). Cheques Issue Register

c). Ledger

g). Telephone Register

d). Stock Register

h). Attendance Register

All the transactions are routed through bank; therefore cash book is not maintained.

- 3) The bank account is maintained with the Corporation Bank. The bank account maintained in the books is reconciled on monthly basis with bank statement.
- 4) We have checked all the bills and vouchers and found the same to be generally satisfactory in all respects.
- 5) We have not come across any instance of expenses being incurred without authorizations.

B.Fixed Assets

6) Fixed Assets of the agency were physically verified by us and found it matching with the records maintained. The fixed asset register has been properly maintained and no discrepancies were found.

C. Stock Register

- 7) We have not come across any instance in which Anti dope kits where dispatched to third parties without raising "issue vouchers". In case of in house use "expenses vouchers" are raised. However, Anti dope kits issued to outside private parties, like sponsored/commercial game organizers, at cost price, should be against serially numbered invoices.
- 8) Stock of Anti Dope Kits checked and verified on 25/01/2018, and found it to be correct.
- 9) We have found 25 boxes of urine sampling kit (red/blue) which were not recorded in the stock register as these boxes were received at free of cost. We advise that these boxes of stock should be recorded into the stock register at zero value.
- 10) We have found some discrepancies during stock verification of old dresses lying and found some discrepancies in the stock recorded in the stock register.

D. Statutory Payments

11) TDS is deposited on/before the due date. The various tax compliances in regard to all kind of statutory payments like NPS, TDS is made as per the rules.

E. Expenditure

12) All the expenses have been properly authorized and verified by the relevant authority.

F. Advance to Staff

13) Advance given to staff are properly authorized & verified.

SCHEDULE 24- SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

The financial statements are required to be prepared on the basis of historical cost convention, unless otherwise stated and on the accrual method of accounting.

2. <u>INVENTORY VALUATION</u>

Inventories are valued at lower of cost and of and net realizable value. The costs are based on FIFO basis. Cost of inventory is determined by considering material, labour and related overheads.

3. **INVESTMENTS**

- 3.1 Investments classified as "long term investments" are carried at cost. Provisions for declined, other than temporary, is made in carrying cost of such investments.
- 3.2 Investments classified as "Current" are carried at lower of cost and fair value. Provision for shortfall on the value of such investments is made for each investments considered individually and not on a global basis.
- 3.3 Cost includes acquisition expenses like brokerage, transfer stamps.

4. FIXED ASSETS

- 4.1 Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition. In respect of projects involving construction, related pre-operational expenses (including interest on loans for specific project prior to its completion), form part of the value of the assets capitalized.
- 4.2 Fixed Assets received by way of non-monetary grants, (other than towards the Corpus Fund), are capitalized at values stated, by corresponding credit to Capital Reserve.

5. **DEPRECIATION**

Depreciation is provided on WDV method as per rates specified in the Income Tax Act, 1961.

6. MISCELLANEOUS EXPENDITURE

Deferred revenue expenditure is written off over a period of 5 years from the year it is incurred.

7. ACCOUNTING FOR SALES

Sales include excise duty and are net of sale returns, rebate and trade discount.

8. GOVERNMENT GRANTS/SUBSIDIES

Government grants of the nature of contribution towards capital is disclosed as endowment fund.

9. FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSACTION

- 9.1 Transaction denominated in foreign currency are accounted at the exchange rate prevailing at the date of the transaction.
- 9.2 Current assets, foreign currency loans and current liabilities are converted at the exchange rate prevailing as at the year end and the resultant gain/loss is adjusted to cost of fixed assets, if the foreign currency liability relates to fixed assets, and in other cases is considered to revenue.

10. LEASE

Lease rentals are expensed with reference to lease terms.

11. RETIREMENTS BENEFITS

11.1 Liability towards gratuity payable on death/retirement, and, provision of accumulated leave benefits, of employees is accounted on actual basis. Actuarial valuation is not available.
